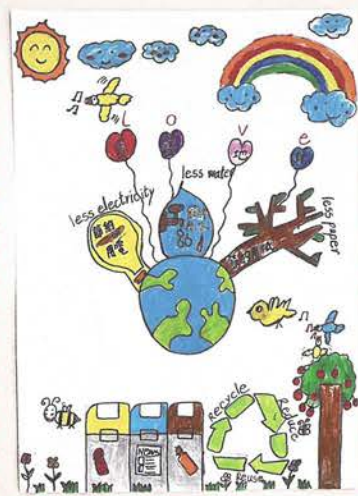


English Programme

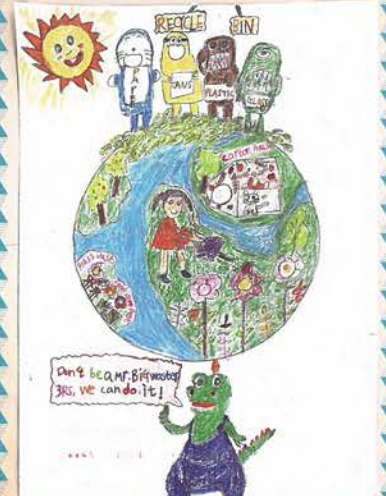

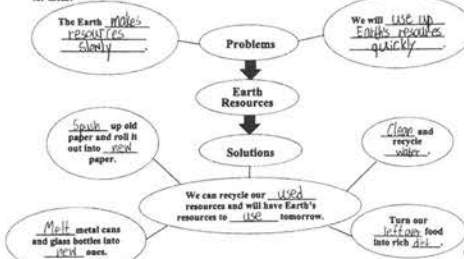

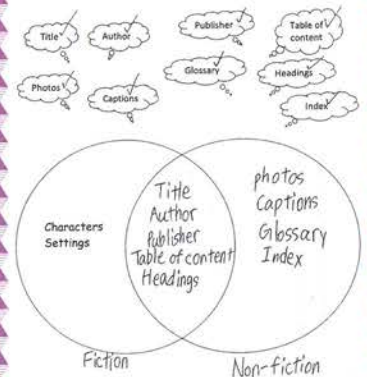
Cluster Diagram

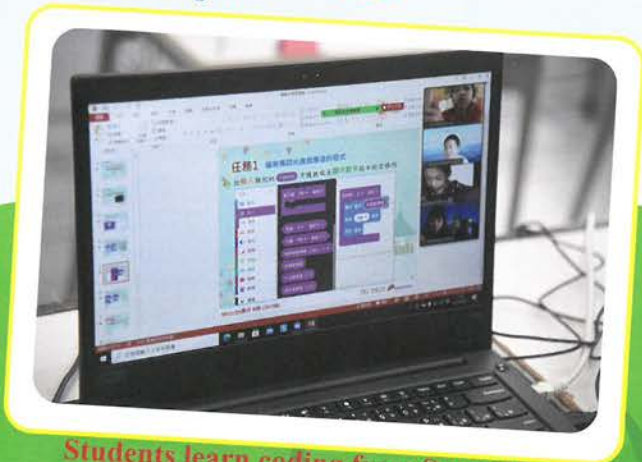

I have a degree in English Literature, which means I love to read, and I love to teach reading even more! Some of my other favourite things are painting, skiing and cooking delicious food.



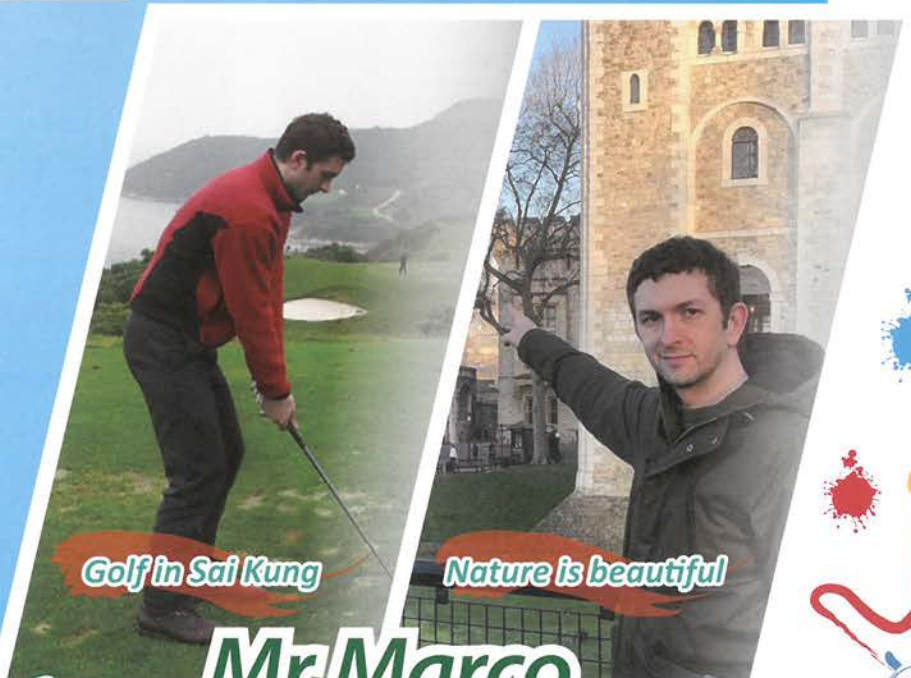
